ICN strongly abhors the lack of access to services by women, their pervasive low socioeconomic status, and societal values that tolerate violence, sexual abuse and other violations of women's rights that are having a direct impact on the health of women and girls. ICN urges Member States to ensure access to SRMNAH services that are provided in a safe and inclusive environment.

ICN also believes that countries must urgently prioritise actions and policies that protect and support the mental health of women, children and adolescents and that mitigate and address the impacts of climate change on their health.
