9-11 May 2022

The World Health Organization, the International Council of Nurses, and the International Confederation of Midwives are pleased to inform you of the 9th "Triad Meeting". The meeting will be held **virtually** via the <u>WHO Nursing and Midwifery Global Community of Practice</u> on **9, 10, and 11 May 2022**.

The meeting will comprise two daily interactive "live streamed" sessions, held at 08:00-10:00 and 15:00-17:00 CEST each day. Interpretation will be available in the WHO official languages and Portuguese.

The focus of the 9th Triad Meeting will be the WHO *Global Strategic Directions for Nursing and Midwifery 2021-2025* and how national nursing and midwifery leaders can advance this new global mandate in their country contexts. The meeting will culminate with a drafting a joint call to action in the Triad Statement. **Please see preliminary agenda below**.

Participants will receive a link to register for the meeting. Upon registration, participants can access the event webpages on the WHO Nursing and Midwifery Global Community of Practice. The registration link will be shared beginning of April 2022; there will be an authentication step required to log-in.

- Participants from the WHO Regions of EURO, WPRO, and SEARO are suggested to attend the morning session: 0800-1000 GMT+2, but may attend whichever session is most convenient for them.
- Participants from the WHO Regions of AFRO, EMRO and PAHO are suggested to attend the afternoon session: 1500-1700 GMT+2, but may attend whichever session is most convenient for them.
