## ICN 2021 Congress Abu Dhabi: Call for Abstracts

**Geneva, Switzerland; 1 June 2020** – The International Council of Nurses (ICN) announced the opening of <u>online abstract submission</u> for the ICN 2021 Congress and Exhibition in Abu Dhabi, UAE today. With the theme, *Nursing the World Together*, the Congress will take place 5-9 June 2021. The on-line submission system will be open from **1 June to 31 July 2020**.

ICN invites nurses and others around the world to share their ideas, research, and expertise by submitting abstracts for the scientific programme. The deadline for abstract submission is **31 July 2020**.

- 2. Epidemics and Pandemics: Nurses' Experiences, Responses, and Policy Recommendations
- 3. Nursing Regulation and Education
- 4. Quality and Safety
- 5. Nursing Care and Advanced Practice Nursing
- 6. Nursing Workforce
- 7. Global Health Challenges
- 8. Digital Health and Innovation

Congress participants who are members of ICN member associations will be able to observe global nursing leaders, identify the profession's priorities and future directions.
