

## New report released on ICN contributions to resumed session of WHA73 and WHO EB148

**Geneva, Switzerland, 4 March 2021** – The International Council of Nurses (ICN) has released a new <u>report</u> detailing its contributions to the 73rd World Health Assembly (WHA73) and the 148<sup>th</sup> WHO Executive Board meeting (EB148).

On 9-14 November 2021, the World Health Organization (WHO) held a resumed session of the 73<sup>rd</sup> World Health Assembly following the reduced (*de minimis*) meeting of 18-19 May 2020. See <a href="here">here</a> for WHA73 closing remarks by ICN CEO Howard Catton.
